GENERAL CAMP RULES

Respect each other's property. **Respect** the rooms, the cabins, furniture, camp ground facilities and the rules that have been put into place. If you break something you will be charged for its repair or replacement.

Rooms and cabins are to be kept clean and neat at all times. Any damaged property will be replaced at the student's expense.

Chewing gum is not permitted.

Be polite to everyone. Rudeness in any form or at any time will not be tolerated.

Closed in shoes must be worn at all times.

Do not leave your room or cabin at night. Stay in your own room or cabin at night. When instructed to go to bed and turn out the lights, do so. Boys and girls are **never** to be inside the cabin of students of the opposite sex at any time.

As is the case with all College activities, tobacco, alcohol and drugs are **prohibited**. Any students found with these substances will have their parents called to come and collect them. Students will also face further disciplinary action back at the College. All medication must be given to the Performing Arts Coordinator on arrival at the venue and will be administered at camp when needed.

I wish my child to attend the Music Camp at **The Sydney Academy of Sport and Recreation** from **Wednesday June 26, 2019 at 5:00pm** until **Friday June 28, 2019 at 4:30pm**. I give permission for my child, to attend the excursion described above, which I understand has been approved by the College Principal, I/We,

1. consent for my child to travel on or in any form of public or private transport where such transport is deemed by the school to be necessary or desirable for the safe conduct of the excursion,
2. consent for my child to participate in all activities, outings, trips and functions arranged as part of this excursion (refer below),
3. consent for the school, by its servants or agents:
 - to seek such medical or dental advice on behalf of my child as seen fit in the event of accident or illness, and
 - if, in the opinion of an attending medical or dental practitioner or medical officer ('health practitioner') my child requires medical or dental attention or treatment (including but not limited to the administration of anesthetic, blood transfusion or the performance of any surgical operation), to that health practitioner giving such attention or treatment *provided* that reasonable efforts are made to inform me of any serious injury or illness,
4. certify that the consent which I have given in paragraph three is valid at all times while my child is in the custody of the College while attending or participating in the excursion,
5. certify that I understand that the College will take reasonable care in the event of my child suffering accident or illness but that it will not be responsible for the costs of any medical or dental attention or treatment administered to my child in such event nor will it be directly responsible for any act or omission of any *health practitioner* attending or treating my child,
6. certify that if my child should bring or consume drugs, alcohol or cigarettes or otherwise exhibit behaviour that seriously endangers themselves or others, I will bear the full cost of return transport home for my child and any adult supervisor that may be required to ensure the safety of my child during that transport, and
7. agree to the general camp rules as stated on the permission note.
